
# PA District Art Show




# *Intermediate painting & drawing*


This final installment of images are 18" x 24" charcoal on paper.





Bucks County Impressionist William Lathrop  
lived and worked

Lathrop was instrumental in the founding of Phillips Mill, an 18th-century stone mill that became the leading exhibition location for the New Hope Art Colony of Pennsylvania impressionists. The mill was located opposite Lathrop's home on River Road, north of New Hope. The Lathrop home was the place of many gatherings of artists: These early "members" included the artists Rae Sloan Bredin, Fern Coppedge, John Folinsbee, Daniel Garber, Mary Elizabeth Price, Edward Redfield, and Walter Schofield.
